- *I will keep you informed on details as they become available.











SOAR Above the line

- *Above line- behavior is appropriate and acceptable
- *Relow the line-behavior is inappropriate
 - "Do you want to fix it, or do you want to consequence it?"
 - The STUDENT is responsible for deciding the best way to fix their actions, this allows for the opportunity for students to have ownership
 - **Rollom line-serious rule infraction, violation of district policy


