*Dislricl-Wide Behavior Srslem *Goal- for every student to feel safe in their learning environment

* Above the line Expectalions:
*S-Safe * O- On Task
*A- Act Responsibly * R- Respect


## SOAR Above the line

*Above the line-behavior is appropriate and acceptable

* Below the line-behavior is inappropriate
- "Do you want to fix it, or do you want to consequence it?"
- The STUDENT is responsible for deciding the best way to fix their actions, this allows for the opportunity for students to have ownership *Bollom line-serious rule infraction, violation of district policy

* Yellow- Fix-It Plan or Consequence-It
* Red- Office Referral or Immediate Consequence

## SOAR Above the line

* If your child flips their card throughout the day, a note will be sent home detailing what occurred (see the sample on the next slide)
*lf no nole comes home, then things are qoing well!
