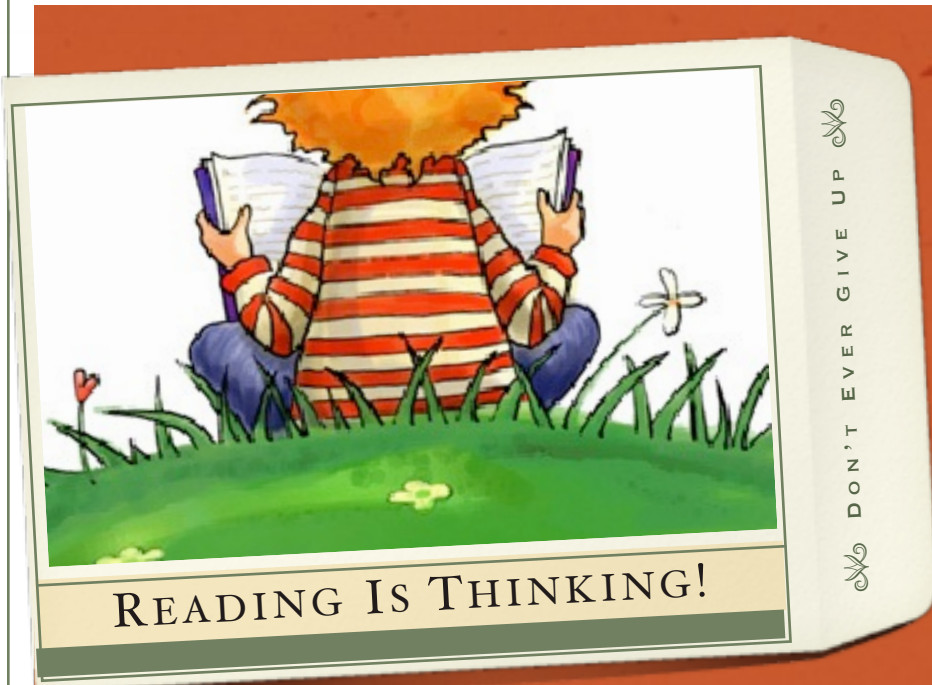


HOW TO CHOOSE A JUST RIGHT BOOK

You don't want a book that is **TOO EASY!**

You don't want a book that is **TOO HARD!**

You **WANT** a book that is **JUST RIGHT!**



Criteria for Choosing Books

A book is **TOO EASY** if...

- You have read it lots of times before.
- You have understand the story real well.
- You know almost ever word.
- You can read the story smoothly.

A book is **TOO HARD** if...

- There are more than 5 words on a page you don't know.
- You are confused about what is happening in most of the book.
- It sounds pretty choppy when you read.

A book is **JUST RIGHT** if...

- The book is new or you have read only a few times.
- You understand most of the book.
- There are just a few words you don't know on a page.
- Sometimes you are smooth and sometimes you are choppy.
